PORTS OF CALL

SANTORINI, GREECE

Famed for its spectacular sunsets, this island in the Aegean Sea is an artifact of an enormous volcanic eruption thousands of years ago. Behold a panorama of indigo-domed churches and chalk-colored homes clinging to stony cliffs along the caldera, black sand beaches dotted with pebbles beside deep, azure waters, and breathtaking rock formations climbing from the volcanic floor—here is the epitome of Greek beauty.

EPHESUS/KUSADASI, TURKEY

The port of Kusadasi, recently a fishing and farming village, is today a resort town offering lovely beaches and plenty of shops. Nearby, is the legendary ruined city of Ephesus, a veritable museum of Greek and Roman history with impeccably preserved relics from its ancient past. Here you'll find the Library of Celsus, the incredible Terraced Houses, and the remains of the Temple of Artemis—one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

RHODES, GREECE

Rich in history and steeped in legend, the largest of the Dodecanese (or Twelve Islands) is located on the eastern edge of the Aegean Sea. Home to an ancient acropolis, white-washed towns and the medieval walled city known as Rhodes Town, the island's stunning scenery is of equal splendor—dreamy beaches and an average of more than 300 days of sunshine each year.

MYKONOS, GREECE

Amid the shimmering waters of the Mediterranean is the heart and soul of the Cyclades: Mykonos. Situated on an island of the same name, the town artfully balances glitz, glamour and classic Greek culture with its labyrinth of cobblestone streets and chalk-white houses beside classic blue-domed churches.

KAVALA, GREECE

Crowned by a Byzantine fortress, the second largest city in northern Greece rests on an ascending slope along the palm-lined Bay of Kavala. Its modern town is home to neoclassical museums and the Tobacco Museum of Kavala—representing the integral role of tobacco in the city's wealth and prosperity. The Old City brims with cultural landmarks like the Castle, the Acropolis, the Imarent and the Old Lighthouse.

ISTANBUL, TURKEY

Indulge your eyes and senses in this magnificent city astride two continents and divided by the Bosphorus. Once known as Constantinople, Istanbul was the capital of both the Byzantine and Ottoman Empire, and is now a fascinating blend of ancient and cosmopolitan—home to the impressive Blue Mosque, Topkapi Palace and the fascinating Grand Bazaar.
